Community Service Project Christian Ethics 20

Goals:

To promote an attitude that recognizes service as an important part of Christian living

To provide students with an opportunity to grow as Christians by following Jesus' example of compassionate service to others

Guidelines:

- 1. The student is expected to serve a total of **eight** hours volunteering in the community.
- 2. These hours of service may be offered to
 - a) an agency or organization
 - b) someone outside the student's circles of family and friends
 - c) a special service to a needy family member or friend.
- 3. The student may not receive payment for any service provided.
- 4. The student may volunteer all hours at one organization **or** split the hours between different organizations.
- The student is responsible for completing the Community Service Hours Sheet listing the name of agency, name of supervisor, contact information of supervisor, date, number of service hours, activity, signature of supervisor, evaluation by supervisor.
- 6. When a student has completed the community service project, the student must :
 - a) write a Community Service Hours Reflection
 - b) submit the Community Service Hours Sheet and Community Service Hours Reflection by the end of the term.
