

## Accessing R.O.V.E.R.

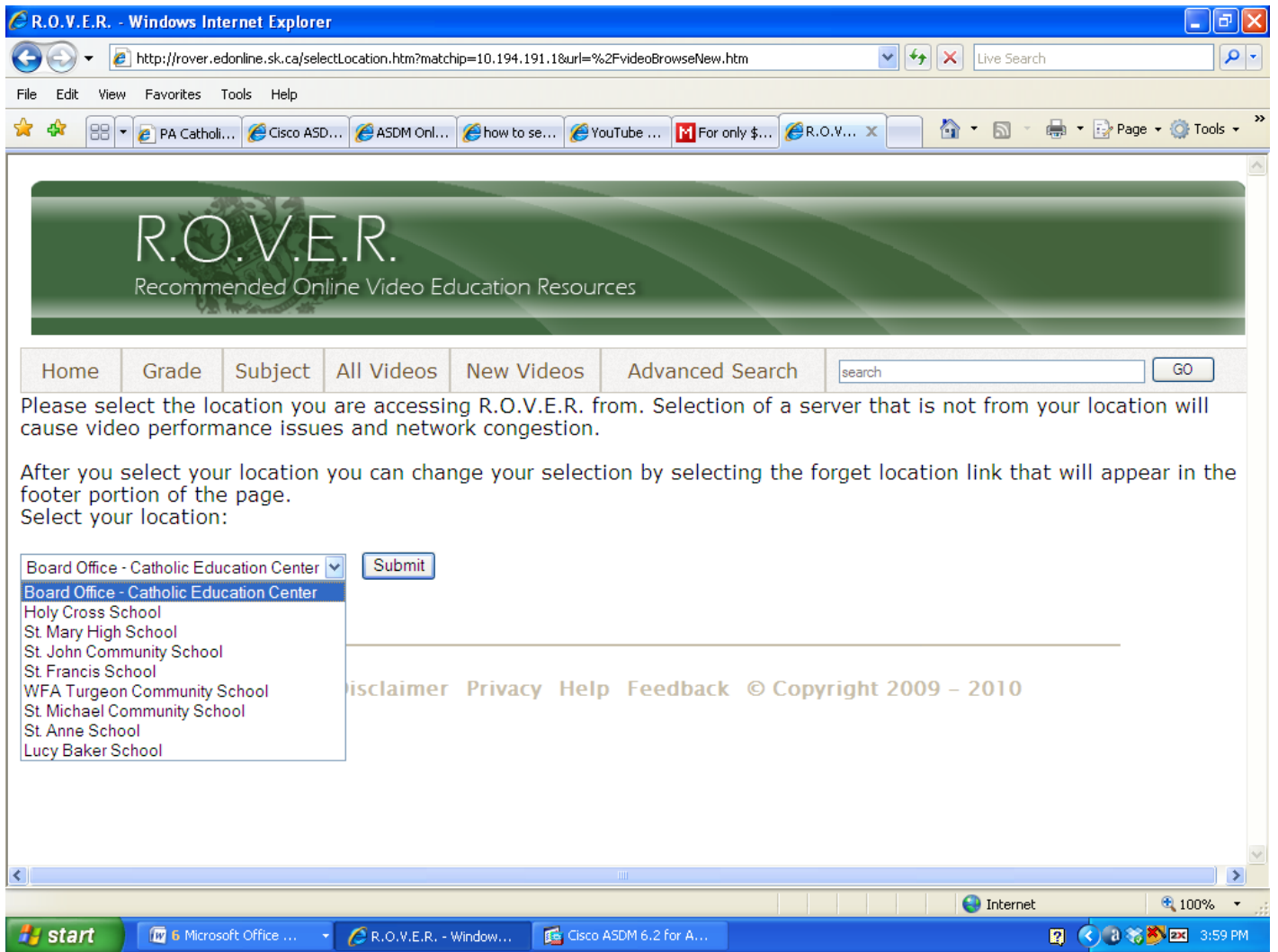
Open Internet Explorer

In the address bar type in **http://rover.edonline.sk.ca** and then press Enter

**Click on the down arrow and then choose your school**
