

Differentiation Using Technology

Differentiation includes changes to the learning environment which provides students with access to their learning.

The overall goal of this is for every individual to learn to access the content independently.



These are individual ways content or instructions need to be presented to a student in order to provide equitable and inclusive access to instruction.

Opportunities for Differentiation

- Use multiple modalities such as written and verbal
- Minimize distractions on the page
- Embed verbal instructions using the audio recording feature in OneNote
- Modify assignments and send to individual students
- Issue differentiated work in Class Notebook
- Verify that materials are accessible before distributing
- Upload videos to Stream to allow automatic transcripts to be generated.
- Use live captions to allow multiple language pupils to follow what you are saying.




Immersive Reader







Office Lens & Immersive Reader


- Turn print into digital content.


A long time coming! Sainsbury's Christmas ad shows a festive family gathering frozen in time, hinting at last year's lockdown misery, before the celebrations re-start

Sainsbury's Christmas advert for 2021 has used last year's lockdown for its inspiration, with the minute-long commercial dedicated to families being reunited this year.

The advert, set to Etta James' classic At Last, and narrated by Stephen Fry, depicts a family's Christmas dinner in full flow - with champagne flowing and the piano being played - before the fun is frozen in time.

The advert, which premiered on ITV during the Angela Black Special and on Youtube, invites people to savour every second of their Christmas celebrations this year.

2020 saw many people spending yuletide alone or far from their families after Boris Johnson unveiled strict measures just before the big day.

■ Hard-to-read text contrast

Food Product Development

when viewing documents in bright light.




- Researcher uses Bing to pull in the appropriate content from the web and provide structured, safe and credible information.

- Tap See all images to open the image gallery. Choose the plus sign to add the image to your document






Microsoft Stream

Stream can automatically generate captions using Automatic Speech Recognition technology.

Captions are used in three ways:

- When watching a video, you can select to see captions at the bottom of the video.
- Captions are concatenated to form a transcript.
- Captions are indexed, so you can go directly to a specific location in a video.








Microsoft Translate

- Good for Modern Languages Students to practice speaking.









