## Calculating an admission average

An admission average is calculated using subjects and grades that appear on applicants' high school transcripts using this five-mark formula:

In order to study some university-level courses, students are required to have completed certain high school classes. For example:

- To study university-level biology, chemistry or physics, the Grade 12 (senior-level) course of the same subject is required.
- To study university-level calculus, Grade 12 (senior-level) pre-calculus or a university-level pre-calculus class is required.

## Saskatchewan transcripts

Saskatchewan high school students must request transcripts to be sent directly to the University of Saskatchewan by the Ministry of Education. To arrange for transcripts to be sent automatically as they are available, remember to select:

- as soon as possible,
- after January exams 2025, and
- after June exams 2025\*\*

\*\*Final grades for all subjects are needed to ensure admission conditions are met. If not received by August 1, it may impact students' admission and ability to enroll.
